

**PER CREDIT HOUR FEE POSTPONED**

**URGENT NOTICE-SAVE MONEY ON CE**

Illinois was set to switch to a course reporting fee structure beginning on 7/16/10 but announced a few days before implementation that these fees would be postponed until later in 2010 or perhaps as of January 1, 2011. It is not currently known what the per course hour assessment will be upon implementation but it was originally pegged at \$1 per credit hour. We will post the correct amount and start date of reporting fees once it is provided to us officially from the Dept of Insurance.

The Illinois Dept of Insurance will be "out-sourcing" the provider course reporting function to a company called State Based Systems (SBS). This means that **ALL COURSE PROVIDERS, like Dohrn Insurance Training, Inc., will be required to pay a per credit hour REPORTING FEE before a producer's education credits can be counted.** Dohrn earns **NONE** of this reporting fee.

**ALSO NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO REPORTING OF ANY COURSE CREDIT BY ANY ILLINOIS PROVIDER DURING THE PERIOD OF JULY 16, 2010 UNTIL JULY 26, 2010.**

**THE REPORTING FUNCTION RESUMES AGAIN ON JULY 26, 2010. During this period a new reporting method will be implemented which uses National Producer Number (NPN) reporting to replace the use of Social Security numbers for the reporting of CE credit (Socials will still be used for initial licensing candidates, however..**

Up until now there has never been any charge to report your course credits, therefore this fee must be passed on to you, the consumer. This new fee applies to Continuing Education credit AND to Prelicensing.

**CONSIDER GETTING SELF STUDY HOURS IN YOUR CREDIT BANK WITH THE STATE BEFORE THESE FEES GO INTO EFFECT.**
